



- Legally constituted in Milan, Italy
- Italian and English versions of the constitution are available to view on the EMBA website.
- Primary objective of EMBA is to promote breastfeeding

Promotes international cooperation between human milk banks and national and international milk bank associations.

Organises international conferences every 2 years

Will now also organise an international research meeting every intervening year.

The next conference will be held in Turin, Italy on October 10th and 11th 2019.
